NOMINATIONS

Nominations are solicited to fill four Board of Directors positions and the President-Elect position. The deadline for receiving nominations is Wednesday, November 18, 2009.

You may nominate yourself or any other Association member. All nominees must have been members of the Association for at least three consecutive years, and nominees for President-Elect must be from the Regulatory Category (Government) and also have previously served on the Board of Directors for at least one year. The Nominating Committee will screen the nominees and submit a slate of candidates for consideration by the Board of Directors in January 2010. The election will be held during the spring 2010.

The nomination package should be limited to *five pages*: the Nomination Form (see below), one-page resume, and a brief description of the nominee's interests/qualifications under the following six criteria: vision for the Association, time commitment/support from employer, leadership skills, knowledge of A&WMA/its products and services, financial literacy, and written and verbal communication skills.
