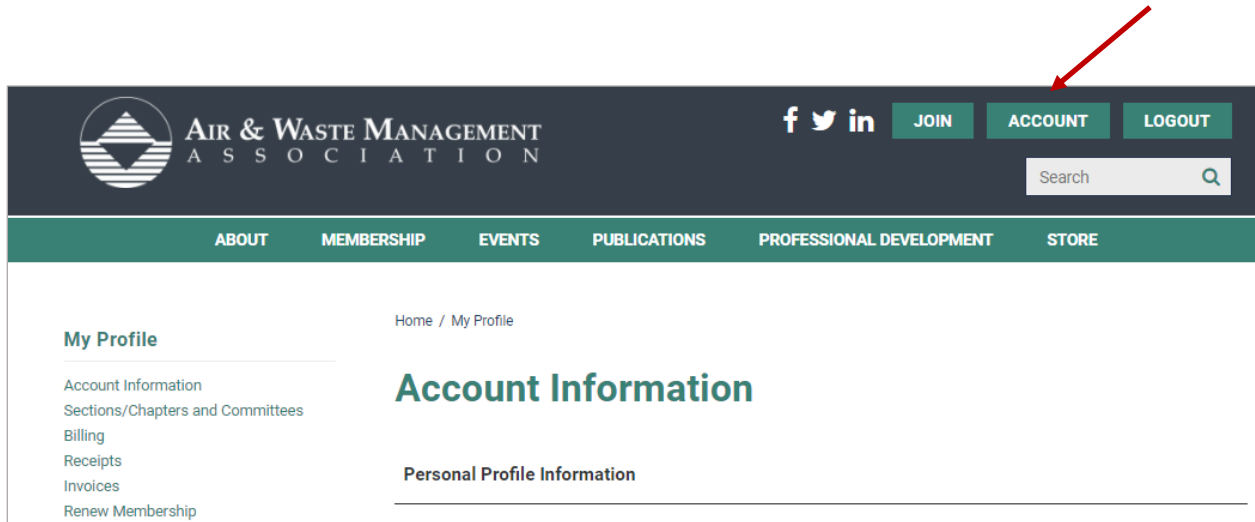


# Wildfires Virtual Conference Access Instructions
