Richard I. Stessel was a Professor of Civil and Environmental Engineering at the University of South Florida. He influenced A&WMA's Technical Council to include greener, energy-efficient, and integrated engineering solutions in solid and hazardous waste management.

Jacqueline Shields was a former A&WMA board member and an Honorary Fellow member.
